


PART 3 - PREDICTIONS OF A COMING MESSIAH

Micah 5:2-5




THE MESSIAH HAD TO:

Be born in Bethlehem - Micah 5:2 Be raised in Galilee near Nazareth - Isaiah 9 Be despised and rejected by men - Isaiah 53 Be meek and silent before his accusers - Isaiah 53 Be pierced for forgiveness of sins - Isaiah 53 Be crucified - Psalm 22 Have his garments divided and gambled over - Psalm 22 Be betrayed for 30 pieces of silver - Zechariah 11 Come to Jerusalem about AD 33 - Daniel 9 Live during the age of the Romans - Daniel 2
